Anti-Bacterial Technology - A Powerful Feature for Better Protection against Bacteria and Germs

Our Family Care Series models are protected with an antibacterial glaze to prevent bacterial growth and reduce antimicrobial activity. This protection is certified under JIS Z 2801 standards, where > 99% of bacteria (specifically E Coli and Staphylococcus aureus, the most commonly found bacteria in our bathrooms) are proven killed upon contact.

Produced under extremely high temperatures, the antibacterial glaze forms a shining and smooth surface on our ceramic products, providing protection that can last a lifetime as long as the glaze is intact.

CARE AND CLEANING FOR ANTI-BACTERIAL PRODUCTS

Saniton's ceramic products are easy to clean and extremely durable for their entire lifetime. However, please note that regardless of its ability to withstand wear and tear, all ceramic products cannot withstand excessive pressure and may easily break, crack or scratch upon sudden impact or misuse.

Abrasive cleaning agents (e.g. scouring powders, drain cleaners), strong acid or alkaline may damage the antibacterial property of the anti-bacterial glaze.

- > When cleaning our product, use a sponge with mild, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly with clear water after cleaning and dry with a soft and slightly moist cloth.
- > AVOID harsh chemicals such as detergents, disinfectants or cleaning products in aerosol cans.
- > Do **NOT** use abrasive cleaning equipment such as abrasive pads or hard brushes.
- Some bathroom chemicals, floor cleaning agents, cosmetics and hair dye may damage the product's ceramic surface or toilet seat's finish.

Cleaning Tips

- > Frequently clean the product to avoid unwanted stains and prolong its aesthetic beauty.
- When tackling stubborn dirt, soak a cloth in the cleaning agent and place it on the stubborn dirt for a few minutes before cleaning.
- > Avoid drying the product with materials that have rough surfaces and/or sharp edges.

Disclaimers

- Clean the product regularly as bacteria may grow on surfaces that are not coated with the anti-bacterial glaze.
